


## The Care Trust DAC

## **Grants Remitted to Beneficiaries**

Full details on grants remitted and how these funds are used by Beneficiaries can be found in The Care Trust financial statements and Annual Report. This is a summary of funds remitted in the last twenty years.

Between 2000 and 2021, The Care Trust provided a total of €49.8 million to CRC¹, Rehab, and the Mater, net of all operating costs.

The Care Trust is owned in equal shares by CRC (Central Remedial Clinic) and Rehab and has been fundraising, on a national basis, for both of these entities since 1974. The Care Trust also fundraised, by arrangement from 1988 to 2021, for the Mater Misericordiae University Hospital (the Mater).

From 2000 and 2021, The Care Trust remitted a total of €22.5m each to CRC and to Rehab, the shareholders of The Care Trust. Since 2011, the Mater received a fixed amount of €250,000 each year. In 2020, the amount was reduced to €200,000 due to the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on The Care Trust fundraising performance. This amount was further reduced to €175,000 in 2021 but only €72,917 was paid as the agreement with the Mater ended on 27 May 2021.

In 2021, amounts paid under special charitable projects were €65,000 to A Lust For Life and €35,000 to HUGG (Healing for Untold Grief Groups).

Contributors to The Care Trust are entered into monthly draws and a Toyota Corolla Hybrid car is won each month and there are also cash consolation prizes.
